OTTA has recognized five Ontario Team Training Centers (OTTC) for season 2011-12:

All of above centers needs to make sure that their designated coach(es) have minimum Level 2 or Introduction to Competition. They can change or add coaches during a year.

Yearly Schedule

At each OTTC in Toronto area OTTA is offering certain hours of training whit Ontario Coach (to be announced before October 25th). Activities in GTA will start on November 1st. Year (Nov 1st, 2011 – October 31st, 2012) is divided at several periods – three periods during school year, Christmas and March break, summer and June.

Ontario Coach

Ontario coach will:

- Offer 1000 hours a year of training in Toronto area
- Develop close ties with coaches from OTTC (Zhang Lei – Alex TT, Jan Fei Sun – My TTC, Shirley Zhou - CCTA)
- Cooperate with National Team Training Center in Ottawa
- Report to OTTA High Performance Director
- Ontario Team coach act as a head coach at all National and international events.

Making Ontario Team for Nationals

There are several ways to make Ontario Team for Nationals:

- Ontario Champion will have guaranteed spot in a team
- National Team carded athletes (absence from Provincials and some training camp only with permission of TT Canada)
- Achieved results at Ontario Championship and other relevant competitions (to be announced before January 1st); however, athletes that resides less than 50 km from any of five OTTCs will need to complete at least 100 hours a year of practice with:
 - o Ontario Team Coach (in GTA area) or
 - o OTTA appointed coach (in Ottawa)

At least 67 hours should be completed before Nationals and at least 100 hours should be booked before June 15th, 2012

- An athlete that lives outside of above described area has to present yearly plan that will be coordinated with his/her coach and Ontario Team coach.

Carded Athletes

A) Carded athletes in season 2011-12

If carded athlete resides less than 50 km from any of five Ontario Team Training Centers he/she will have to complete certain number of hours with Ontario Team coach (if resides in GTA area) or OTTA designated coach (if resides in Ottawa area)

- a) Full carded at least 200 hours in a year (at least 60 hours should be completed before February 29th, 2012 and 200 booked before March 11th, 2012);
- b) Half carded at least 100 hours in a year (at least 30 hours should be completed before February 29th, 2012 and 100 booked before March 11th, 2012).

If carded athlete attends university or college in Canada that is more than 50 km far from one of OTTCs, but his/her primary residence is closer than 50 km from one of OTTCs:

- At least 100 hours needs to be completed during a year with Ontario Team coach (if primary residence is in GTA area) or OTTA designated coach (if primary residence is in Ottawa area)
- During his/her time at university or college athlete should establish cooperation with suitable coach (minimum Level 2 or Introduction to Competition) that will work with him/her and cooperate with Ontario Team coach and HP Director.

All carded athletes should complete minimum of 400 hours in a year at one of Ontario Team Training Centers (a and b inclusive).

Carded athlete that lives more than 50 km of OTTCs has to present yearly plan that will be coordinated with his/her coach and Ontario Team coach. He/she should also complete 400 hours of training in a year.

B) Carded athletes in season 2012-13

An athlete that is planning to apply for carding status in season 2012-13 and living in 50 km radius from any of five OTTCs will need to complete at least 100 hours

- o With Ontario Team coach (for one living in GTA area) or



- OTTA designated coach (for one living in Ottawa area)

All athletes (A and B) will have responsibility to have log which designated coach should sign after every training session.

Booking time

Procedure to book training sessions with Ontario Team coach:

- Send your preferred time before each period
- Ontario Coach and HP Director will do its best to coordinate with athletes and their parents in order to get groups with similar strength
- Ontario Coach target is to work with groups of 6 players
- You will be informed soon about your training schedule.

Price

Athletes that are taking more hours will have significant discount.

Number of hours in a year	Price per hour
49 or less	\$ 12.00
50-99	\$ 11.00
100-399	\$ 10.00
400 - 699	\$ 9.00
700 and more	\$ 8.00

Number of hours will accumulate during a year and invoice for each period will be adjusted to reflect number of overall taken hours.

Six players that take the most classes will have opportunity to be coached by Ontario Team coach(es) and pay 30\$ per day at Nationals and other relevant competitions.

If there are needs and opportunities to hire other coaches for competitions fees will be at least 50\$ per day for each additional coach.
